**GVR Clay Studio at Santa Rita Springs 399-2755 REQUIRED**

**1 Bag of Clay. The clay must be purchased at GVR Clay Studio.  
Prefer you use Paper Clay**

**1 metal potter's needle available at the clay studio about \$5**

**3 heavy brown paper grocery bags**

**1 "Stencilers" brush. Short Stiff, Thick Bristles. Size 6. Can obtain  
from Michaels Store.**

**1 piece of plywood 1/2" thick 20"x 24" (It can be an old used piece;  
1/4" is okay if it is a straight even piece of hard board that does not  
bend.)**

*2 pieces of your own heavy weight canvas 22x24 (Do not attach to board)*

**During first class we will identify the canvas and board with your  
name in permanent ink.**

**If you cannot obtain your own heavy-medium weight canvas cloths,  
I will make them for you. It will cost about \$4 for 2 of them.
