Coast Guard approved life vests for small children are available for Member use at each pool location.

▼ Salt-water pools

Various types of "water equipment" have been approved for use in therapeutic or physical water exercises. They are Aqua Socks, goggles/masks, kickboards, swim fins, Aqua Joggers, snorkels and swim noodles when these items are used for exercise and rehabilitation purposes. Still prohibited are rafts, beach balls, tubes, children's water toys, inflatable armbands, diving objects.

Not all pools have rope/lane dividers. PLEASE observe posted lap lane signs.
